

We are pleased to announce that the registration page for the 2017 LHON society conference on Saturday 23rd September is now open and tickets and accommodation can be reserved and purchased on a first come first served basis by following this link:

Once we have processed your request (please allow up to 48 hours), we will send you an email invoice which you can pay using either a credit/debit card or Paypal.

We can only refund fees up until 30 days before the event in case you need to cancel, unless someone on the waiting list can take your place. We regret that the venue does not allow children under the age of 12 on the premises.

The cost of attending the conference is heavily subsidised at £25 per delegate which includes lunch and refreshments during the day and an evening function to be held at the venue (either barbecue or buffet depending on the weather). Accommodation is available on Saturday 23rd September and the cost is £50 for a double room including breakfast.

The agenda will include scientific and medical presentations by Professor Patrick Chinnery and Dr Patrick Yu Wai Man, a patient panel and presentation on low vision rehabilitation from a leading Swedish expert who has LHON himself. There will be presentations from other patient groups in Europe, Findacure (the leading organisation supporting patient groups in the UK) and EURORDIS.

In two side rooms we will have representatives from E-Sight and Orcam who will be giving some demonstrations and further information on their visual aid devices.

The conference will start at 11:00am on Saturday 23rd and we will arrange transport from Cambridge railway station for those arriving by train. There is free parking onsite and fast train connections to Cambridge station from Stansted airport.
